# Flood Affected People in Sindh

In this catastrophic situation, around twenty millions are affected by the worst ever floods in the history of Sindh which wreak havoc all across the country and erased hundreds of the villages while depriving millions of their homes, belongings, savings, beloved ones and lives forever. This situation triggered massive humanitarian crises that have threatened the lives and well-being of millions of people in the flood waters' path, particularly villagers and residents of (KACHA) riverine areas of Sindh, claiming over 2500 lives.

Most of the remote parts of Northern & Southern have been badly hit and towns including Kandhkot, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Ghotki, Sukkur, Shikarpur, Larkana, Khairpur, Noshehro Feroz, Qamber, Dadu and Thatta have been inundated and damaged severely, more than a million helpless people are still encircled by water.

Takhleeq Foundation has responded with the basic needs of these affected communities through repaid assessment and also took part in rapid Assessment by UNOCHA in for districts by partnering with district governments and local NGOs network.

Takhleeq Foundation's emergency response activities started with assessing the situation and urgently responded in Ghotki, Qamber Shahdadkot & Shikarpur and declared emergency by deputed staff in these districts. Takhleeq Foundation also involved the community trained volunteers during flood in 2007 and asked them to rush to Ghotki and relief tasks

Takhleeq Foundation established emergency response camps in Ghotki and provided basic information and providing water, sanitation, health services, NFIs to 1500 families

## **Water and Sanitation Hygiene (WASH)**

For safe drinking water and sanitation Takhleeq Foundation installed 30 hand pumps and distributed aqua tab for clean water for 1500 families. In addition to that Takhleeq Foundation also installed 30 soft pit latrine facilities for flood affected peoples in district Ghotki with the support of UNICEF.

## **Medical Camps**

To address the health needs Takhleeq Foundation provided health facilities to flood affected people in Ghotki and treated approximately 1248 patients through mobile camp and coordinated with Taluka Hospital for back up support in case of any emergency. There is also one normal delivery in flood camps. This intervention provided the medical services to the sick, and injured including preventive for rabbis or different viral, fungal, bacterial and other diseases.

## **Health & Hygiene**

Takhleeq Foundation staff also conducted health & hygiene sessions with the affected communities in the relief camps in district Ghotki.

### **Distribution of Family Health & Hygiene kits**

Data assessment was completed for 1500 families to distribute family health and hygiene kits

## **Psycho Social Camps**

Takhleeq Foundation also initiated psychosocial and health hygiene education school for flood affected children and would like to initiate it as tent school in Ghotki. This is the first step towards rebuilding the psychosocial & educational support from scratch.

## **Urgent Relief Needs**

Thousands of people still surrounded by water and there is need to urgently respond the emergency especially for Thatta, Badin, Larkana & Shikarpur. There is also need to provide Food Ration along with Shelter, Health, WASH, and Livestock services to 10,000 families and is looking for resource to provide full package to 10,000 more families on very URGENT basis. People are sitting in open air and they need temporary Shelter.

There is need of about 10,000 tents, plastic sheets are required for this purpose an in addition to that, there is threat of spread of Diseases like Diarrhea to Children and Skin Diseases in other districts and also needed the animal feed and vaccinations to prevent the loss of further livestock.
