

1. Child Protection

A.) Advocacy & Awareness on Women & Children Rights through Radio Program

The majority of Pakistani women belong to the silent illiterate majority which led their lives with physical hardship and involving themselves in longer hours at tedious chores, for which there is neither compensation nor recognition. Takhleeq Foundation initiated to replicate the flow of information on women and child rights by using the electronic media to the rural population to utilize the efficacy and effectiveness of electronic media for wider spread of the rights based issue for awareness raising and also for advocacy at micro and macro level.

Achievements:

Before the intervention, it was noticed that women were not allowed to get out of their homes in the remote areas due to the pressure of the male members in the family. But the awareness campaigns and the dialogues and discussions have forced women to get out of their homes and participate for the rights and the justice they deserve. Women, now actively participate in raising issues related to marriages, financial rights, domestic violence etc. Realizing the issue is the foremost thing. Through Takhleeq Foundation's intervention, women are aware of their rights and their children's rights. Now effort needs to be made in order to get them to the same level in the society so that there is no issue of a male-dominant society in the rural.

Takhleeq Foundation arranged two workshops (one in Hyderabad and other in Khairpur) for advocacy the issues with GOs, NGOs and other civil society components to share the experiences and impact assessment and developed Radio Program SUJJAG to broadcast on Hyderabad Radio Station & Khairpur Radio Station

Takhleeq Foundation hold different advocacy meetings & workshops with writer, Producer, Artists, Radio Station Director, Studio & Production Team. Hold back search & compilation of data on priority issues and organized advocacy workshop at Khairpur and Hyderabad with CSOs, CBO Listeners club, Radio Station Authorities, media persons. Takhleeq Foundation developed ½ hour Radio Program (Drama-cum-Feature) and broadcasted on air form two radio station and shared the schedule with community groups & NGOs & CBOs

B.) Women & Child Protection in Emergency

A Rapid Child Protection Assessment on Vulnerable Children, Single & Female-Headed Households undertaken by Department of Social Welfare, NGOs and UNICEF reflect that more than 5,000 separated and orphaned children and 3,000 vulnerable women in different areas are there. The child protection program is proposed model integrated community-based child protection initiatives with referral and follow-up services in order to ensure prioritization of access to basic (medical support, education and water) and protective services (legal support, psycho-social assistance and other schemes). The project also strengthened procedures for the identification and recovery of women and children made vulnerable to violence, abuse, neglect and exploitation in the area.

Takhleeq Foundation supported for low cost construction of Child Friendly Spaces and identify & recruit teachers/facilitators for Child Friendly Spaces and provided psycho-social support and hold outreach community meetings for enrolment of children and adolescents in the Child Friendly Spaces for social mobilization daily functions and LSBE training of trainers for adolescents with psycho-social support and referral. Takhleeq Foundation also bridged linkages with PCCWD and NCCWD, therapeutic centers for nutrition, breast-feeding and other services and hold Gender-based violence orientations. For identification Takhleeq Foundation hold orientation sessions with NADRA and UC officials on birth registration and interaction with community on importance of registration. Organize mobile teams of NADRA to conduct camps for issuing of ID cards and B form for children. For building the capacities, TF organized training workshops for data-collectors and staff of Social Welfare and NGOs on the use of monitoring tools and also on Protection in humanitarian settings, on Gender-based violence.

C.) Child Rights Protection

Takhleeq Foundation planned for worker's rights protection in partnership with ISCOS-CISL with the support of EU focused in Hyderabad, Thatta & Karachi with the purpose to organize & build the capacities through education and training workshops and bridge with national and global issues & promote basic human value based understanding of child rights & systems by defending CRC & ILO covenants & conventions.

Takhleeq Foundation initiated strategic intervention through Awareness – Analysis – Action and involved print media in putting issue at public level and organized street theater, public seminar, capacity building training workshops at community and district level. Voices of street children were recorded and broadcasted on FM radio station, and working children were involved in education & extracurricular activities. Takhleeq Foundation formed street children groups organized & composed 50 – 100 children to involve in education and counseling. Small sessions were organized & also involved them in street theater, public rallies, mobilization campaign.

Takhleeq Foundation also formed working children schools in four districts and facilitated them in their education and for extracurricular activities/ psychosocial support. Takhleeq Foundation also established Five Working Children Centers (WCCs) to work as recreational centres for the children who come and get relief by having informal education and games
